GENERIC MASCOTS CLEANING

Fur Parts:

Synthetic fabric woven to simulate the hair. The color is obtained from the texture and not tinted. This fabric is made through the processing of woolly fiber consisting mainly of segmented polyurethane. Careful maintenance: it does not tolerate the high temperatures of the water and / or the iron. It can iron inside out or with a damp cloth but at low temperatures. The fabric individually could be hand washed at 40 ° C, without leaving them in water for a long time. Not squeeze them and let them hang or dry in the dryer at low temperature.

NOT WASHABLE BODIES:

Since they are coupled (lycra + DRYFOAM), it is recommended to use a wet and wrung cloth, focusing on the most stained points and rubbing gently. To remove stubborn stains, never use bleach or aggressive solvents; Provide to wet the sieve with a small amount of detergent for delicate clothes or dishes (quick type) Use a high cloth dampened with water only to remove detergent residues and avoid streaks. However, test the product on non-visible printed parts before proceeding. Alternatively, have it dry cleaned in specialized laundries, noting that the garment is doubled, it is therefore it is necessary to use a nonaggressive washing. EXTERNAL HEADS: for the external heads it is necessary to operate as above but only in the vicinity of the spots without acting on the eyes, mustache, eyebrows or any part that can due to a washing or rubbing break away. After removing stains, comb with a soft brush (good ones for chamois) the hair parts of both the head and the body. For the eyes (transparent colored iris of the eye) use externally only the wet pano and if possible, once dry a sponge of "reviving plastic dashboards" can be found in auto accessories shops or shoe polishers. To refresh the internal parts (inside mask, bellies, internal shoes) from any bad smells due sweat, use specific spray products for carpets and fabrics (coccolino sprayrecommended - FEBREZE by Procter & Gamble tel 800420430 in spray version) or alternatively a shampoo dry (for animals) in the most "critical" points eg neck attachment. Avoid contact of these products with any printed or glued parts. Always allow the parts to dry by ventilating and not closing the costumes in bags or trunks.

WASHABLE BODIES:

bodies / gloves / shoes of this type can be taken to the laundry ... you can spray a delicate degreaser (like Cante Clair) on stubborn stains and put in the washing machine at max 40° and then dry at low temperature (if they can't change the dryer temperature ... standard temperature is fine too) they will come as new ... even if they have any unstitching this is because the sponge does not absorb water and is water repellent.

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<u>INTERNAL HEADS</u>: - For the heads instead use a microfiber cloth soaked in a solution of WATER and DEGREASER (90% - 10% ... then at a guess 3 glasses 6/7 sprayed with degreaser) and passed gently inside the head avoiding EYES but focusing on the retina. Finish everything with a spray disinfectant (funghifida see photo) found in a pharmacy or parapharmacy ... often for skin use. Act with the disinfectant especially at the height of the retina !!!

<u>Lycra Parts</u>: Fabric made and patented by Du Pont with the trade name lycra. This fabric is made through the processing of elastomeric fiber consisting mainly of segmented polyurethane. Its main feature is elasticity. Careful maintenance: it does not tolerate the high temperatures of the water and / or the iron. The fabric individually could be hand washed at 40 ° C, without leaving them in water for a long time. Not squeeze them and let them hang to dry. DO NOT IRON.
